### **1. Passion and Desire in the Spiritual Journey: Introduction to the Diamond Approach**

**Part I:** In this weekend workshop, we will explore our relationship to passion and desire using the methods of the Diamond Approach. ### **3. Soul Psychology and The True Therapist: The Healing Power of the Living Field**
