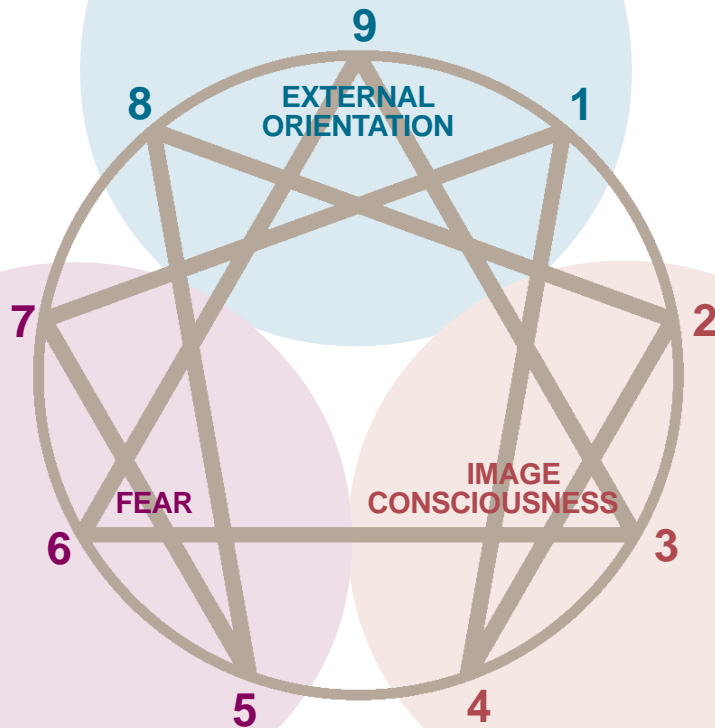


Sandra Maitri

In this workshop, Sandra Maitri will lead an exploration of the three “corners” of the Enneagram from the perspective of issues they present on the Inner Journey. While there are many levels upon which we could discuss the corners, in this workshop we will work with them as three different and central approaches to living that characterize the ego, and are particular orientations that inherently skew our direct experience of reality. We will explore these particular orientations and approaches in terms of how they present particular challenges to the deepening of our inner process. These challenges are universal—common to all of us—no matter what our particular enneatype happens to be nor which spiritual path we are walking. Working with them progressively opens us up to experiencing reality more accurately, without the obscurations of our ego, and so ushers us into the incredible beauty and magnificence of how things really are.

The material will be taught through lectures and experiential exercises, so that participants can personally connect with the territory that the map of the Enneagram points to in their own lives.
